New Business: Coordinator Report

1. Review of LEOP
Next 3 LEPC meetings we will look at different ESF's
2. Hazardous Chemical Releases
December 7th on the KTA an 8,400 Diesel tanker rolled spilling chemicals. Kansas City Hazmat did the clean-up. KTA Patrol does not use the IC system.

West Texas Explosion
Information being sent down on how to improve chemical facilities safety and security.

Tier II Reports have been coming in for 2014 and are on file in our office.

One facility in Lyon County was written up by the EPA for non-compliance.

3. July 2013 flooding is about to be wrapped up.
4. Northeast Region have purchased 3 portable satellite systems for IMT trailers
The locations are Franklin, Lyon and Marshall counties.
5. Rick attended a state focus group of training needs in Topeka.
6. Lyon County Reception & Care Facility Plan is currently being rewritten by Coffey County Emergency Management office. FEMA has given them a deadline of April. The plan at the moment is to decon individuals at the Neosho Rapids Grade School, then utilize ESU for the Reception Center.
7. There will be a 3 day exercise in March to test the capabilities and equipment of the State of Kansas IMT's.
8. TEPW Exercise Calendar:
March 26th a tabletop exercise on Animal Stop Movement
September 24th a functional exercise on Animal Stop Movement
Also a tabletop and full exercise on Active Shooter sometime in the spring or summer.
9. Need to start identifying individuals to be a part of the local Emergency Incident Team.
